Guide Lines for Evaluating Answer Scripts

1. Grammatical accuracy shall have to be followed strictly. Any form of violation of the set rule shall be marked zero (00). In case of any deviation of tenses, mark shall be zero (00).
2. Paragraph Writing:
 - a) 90 percent of the allotted marks shall be awarded for fully satisfactory answer. The paragraph must be written in one paragraph.
 - b) If the paragraph is written in more than one paragraph, in that case, the marking must be zero (00). For every three mistakes (spelling, punctuation, the use of capital and small letters etc.) One mark shall be deducted.
3. For Composition Writing:
 - a) The highest limit of marking is 90 percent of the allotted marks. For every three mistakes (spelling, punctuation, the use of capital and small letters etc.) One mark shall be deducted. If the same spelling mistake occurs in the same answer, in that case, only the first three mistakes shall not be calculated as mistakes of different words.
 - b) Composition written irrelevantly shall carry no marks.
 - c) Twenty percent of the allotted marks shall be given for relevant subject matter.
4. For Letter/Application /E-mail Writing:

- a) Letter/Application Written excluding the body shall be marked zero (00).
 - b) The highest limit of marking shall be 90 percent.
 - c) Letter/Application Written irrelevantly shall carry no mark. For every three mistakes (spelling, punctuation, the use of capital and small letters etc.) One mark shall be deducted.
 - d) Twenty percent of the allotted marks shall be given for relevant subject matter.
5. In the event of answering with and without clues if the targeted word is re-written ignoring the first written one side by side entailing suspicion in the mind of the examiner, 50% marks shall be deducted for the related answer thwart the malpractice.
 6. Any problem arising beyond the scope of the above noted guidelines shall be decided by the department of English and that decision shall be treated as decisive.

Guide line for evaluating answer scripts of Hindu Religion and Moral Education

7. In case of creative questions marks will be awarded according to the stages of skills. In case of incomplete answer, no partial marks will be awarded. If the partial answer is to be expected in lower order thinking instead of higher order thinking, partial marks will be awarded considering the lower order thinking.
8. In case of knowledge stage, the examinees will be awarded 1 mark for right answer, '0' marks will be given for wrong answer. In this case no partial marks will be given.
9. In comprehension stage, 2 or 1 mark may be given. If the partial answer is correct for knowledge stage, 1 mark will be given.
10. For application stage, 3 or 2 or 1 mark may be given.
11. In higher order thinking, 4 or 3 or 2 or 1 mark may be given.
